HACES' Immigrant Family Resource Program (IFRP) ensures that immigrant and mixed-status families, and other limited English-speaking persons reach their goals. We accomplish this by acting to reduce the barriers they inevitably encounter when seeking public benefits, including nutritional and medical benefits. Meanwhile, we provide the basic cash support required for good health, and economic self-sufficiency.

Here's how we do it:



Case management services:

Case managers help immigrants and refugees eliminate the barriers preventing them from applying for public benefits or other human services.



Last fiscal year, our case managers assisted **242** immigrants obtain medical and nutritional public benefits.

Outreach and community education:

Activities to raise awareness about the availability of services that support personal and family well-being and economic self-sufficiency. Our staff regularly updates the community about state and federal policies on public benefits eligibility based on their immigration status.



Last fiscal year, **443** individuals received referrals to food pantries, rent and mortgage help, and other emergency aid.

Covid-19 relief assistance:

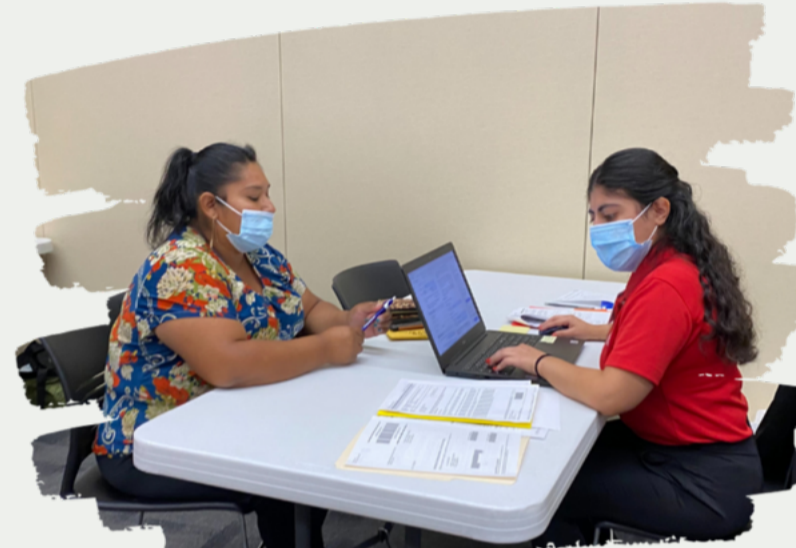
HACES provides case management, disburses relief funds to families and connects them with community services which lightens the burdens they face due to the pandemic.



Last fiscal year, we aided **374** individuals to secure the approval required for COVID cash assistance totaling **\$671,500**.

Health education:

Health is a cornerstone of immigrant integration, as much as education and the ability to speak English. To combat racial health disparities, HACES effectively provides the solution: health education and outreach, bi-monthly educational workshops, and one-on-one health navigation, in a trusted environment and in a language they're comfortable with.



Since the program began, our Health Education Coordinator has counseled **200** Clients helping them find a medical home. Our HACES case manager has so far made contact with over **2,451** individuals to bring them needed information.
