My name is Angela, I am currently a Master's in Social Work candidate at Loyola University and have been working with HACES as an Intern since September 2022. I have been working closely with the New Americans Initiative program, where I have learned the "ins and outs" of the Citizenship application process. Throughout my time here, I have learned how to complete the tedious and complex process of filling out the N-400 application, assisted with gathering the required information and documentation from the clients, and have followed through until the clients participate in their Oath Ceremony. I have also assisted in facilitating HACES' Citizenship classes in Spanish, where I helped students in preparing for their citizenship exam.

Along with my past work experience, my experience with HACES has reinforced the notion that polices are always changing and it is important for us who work closely with populations being affected to be aware of these policies so that we can provide adequate support and services to our community.

As my time with HACES comes to an end, I have come to reflect on my appreciation for this organization as I believe the work being done is of great value to the Latinx community. I have witnessed how the clients not only appreciate the guidance of such complex processes, whether it be applying for citizenship or for public health benefits, but also the support and comfort they receive from the staff members at HACES. Celebrating Success: Highlights from Our Recent Event!

Between January 1, 2022 and April 14, 2023, HACES helped 214 people achieve U.S. citizenship through assistance with the application process and citizenship classes that we provide at no cost to our clients. On Saturday, April 22, HACES hosted its 1 st annual New Citizen Celebration, designed to honor our country's newest citizens, and to thank our citizenship class volunteers; the event was held at

the Warren Newport Public Library.

We had over 75 people in attendance, including: U.S. Representative Brad Schneider (U.S. 10th District), Illinois State Senator Adriane Johnson (IL 30th District), Illinois State Representative Joyce Mason (IL 61st District), and Illinois State Representative Rita Mayfield (IL 60th District).
